We hereby declare our support to ensure the safety and well-being of all persons in custody.

- Open police detention to independent and regular oversight
- Support practices and knowledge for effective policing
- Implement legal and procedural safeguards in custody
- Absolutely reject the use of torture, at all times and in all circumstances.
